Subject: Participating in the Crockett County Site Solo and Ensemble Festival

The WTSBOA Solo and Ensemble Festival held in Alamo on the campus of Crockett County Middle School will begin at 8:00AM.

General Information:

1. Unload students and instruments between Middle School and Vocational Building, and then have buses move to the lot behind the school.
2. There will be an information table outside the warm-up room.
3. Judges rooms will be posted for your convenience.
4. Please have students warm up in the gymnasium before going to the room to be judged.
5. Students should arrive at the judge's door 3-5 minutes before their performance time.
6. Please instruct your students that the playing of instruments is only allowed in the warm up room and the room they are performing in.
7. Make sure your students have a copy of the music with the measures numbered for the judge.
Reminder: all solos and ensembles must be at least 24 measures in length including repeats.
8. Each student should provide a Judge's sheet for the judge upon arrival to the room.
9. After your student has finished performing, have them return to the warm up area and wait for their departure time.
10. Percussion instruments furnished in the band room: Bass Drum, Timpani, and Xylophone. No mallets or sticks of any kind will be provided.

FROM JACKSON

Take **1-40** toward **MEMPHIS**

Take exit **#79** onto **US-412** toward **ALAMO/DYERSBURG** – go approx. **18** mi

Take **CAVALIER DRIVE** exit

Go straight through 4-way stop.

School will be on your left.

FROM MEMPHIS

I-40 – towards **NASHVILLE**

Take **exit #56** toward **BROWNSVILLE/SOMERVILLE** - go 0.2 mi

Turn **Left** on **TN-76** - go 16.3 mi

Turn **Left** on **MAIN ST[TN-88]** - go 0.2 mi

Continue to follow **TN-88** - go 2.6 mi

Turn **Left** onto **US-412** - go 3.6 mi

Take **CAVALIER DRIVE** exit

Go straight through 4-way stop.

School will be on your left.
