DIRECTIONS TO CORDOVA MIDDLE SCHOOL

FROM THE NORTH AND EAST (I-40)

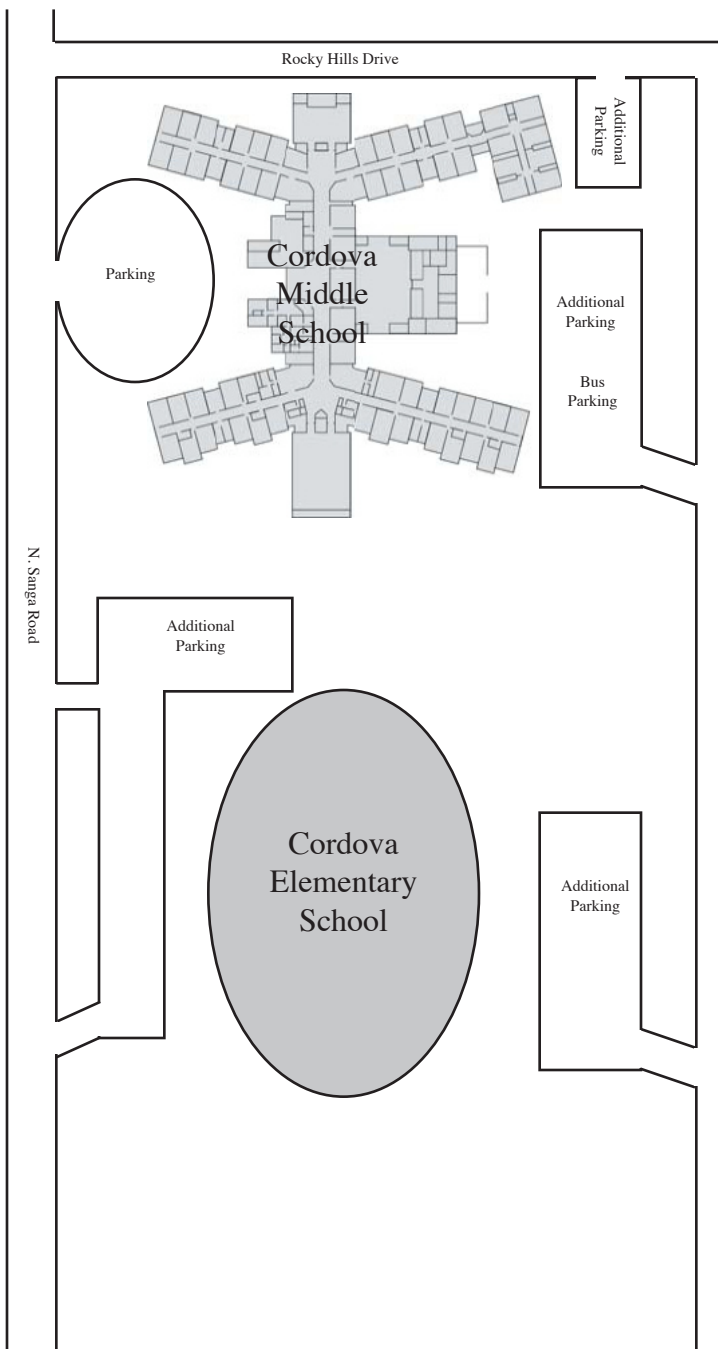
Exit south on Germantown Pkwy (exit 16).
 Travel south for 3 miles.
 Turn left on Trinity Road.
 Travel east to the second stop sign.
 Turn left on Sanga Road.
 Travel north for a quarter of a mile.
 Turn right into Cordova School.

FROM THE SOUTH

Exit North on Germantown Road.
 Travel north past Walnut Grove Pkwy.
 Turn right on Trinity Road.
 Travel east to the second stop sign.
 Turn left on Sanga Road.
 Travel north for a quarter of a mile.
 Turn right into Cordova School.

FROM THE WEST AND SOUTHWEST

Exit east on Walnut Grove Pkwy.
 Travel east for 5 miles.
 Exit Walnut Grove at Germantown.
 Turn left on Germantown Road.
 Travel north for a half mile.
 Turn right on Trinity Road
 Travel east to the second stop sign)
 Turn left on Sanga Road
 Travel north for a quarter of a mile.
 Turn right into Cordova School.



BUSSES

Student drop-off and pick-up for busses and bus parking will be located in the back of the school. Bus drivers should continue east on Trinity road, through the second stop sign and turn left onto Sanga Creek Road. This will provide access to the rear parking lot of the school and the student unloading zone. There is also adequate space to park busses, with overflow bus parking in the rear parking lot of Cordova Elementary School.

PARKING

Parking will be available to all participants and their families. There will be several areas available for parking, including the front, back and kindergarten lots at Cordova Middle School, the main and rear lots at Cordova Elementary school, and additional parallel parking will be available along both sides of N. Sanga Road during the event.

WARM-UP

All students will be provided with an adequate warm-up space. Stands, chairs and pianos will not be provided for warm-up, nor will security be available to secure personal items. Students should be responsible for the security of their belongings.

QUIET AREAS

Please help every student to respect the performances of their peers by keeping the hallways quiet and free of playing, excess noise and loitering.

CONCESSIONS

Food, drinks and snacks will be available for purchase during the event. Prices will range from 50 cents through 2 dollars, dependant on the item. The food will be sold throughout the day at the concession stand outside the gymnasium.
